

Council 6100 Member Service Scholarship

Description and Process Summary

Vision

Intention is to help defray the cost of education for the candidate based upon the active service of the Council 6100 member in 'Good Standing'.

Scholarship

Scholarships will be awarded annually by the Father Joseph A. Cassidy Knights of Columbus Council 6100 to graduating High School students who meet the eligibility requirements.

- Scholarship amount to be awarded is: \$500.00 (one-time payment) to each qualified candidate.
- If no qualified candidate(s) is identified in any particular year, the scholarship(s) will not be presented.

Eligibility Requirements

1. This scholarship is open to any graduating high school student who is a child or ward of a Knights of Columbus Council 6100 member (candidate).
2. Council 6100 member must be in 'Good Standing' with all dues paid through the current calendar year of the candidates' application.
3. Council 6100 member must have a minimum of two years' service as a member of Council 6100 prior to the candidate(s) year of eligibility. As an example, if the candidate(s) is graduating high school in June 2015, the Council 6100 member's date of first degree must be prior to January 1st, 2013 or if the member has transferred from another council, the transfer date must be must be prior to January 1st, 2013.
4. Council 6100 member must be either a current participant in working Bingo or will pledge to begin working Bingo by joining a Bingo team with a commitment of no less than 1 year.
5. Candidate(s) will be continuing their education by attending a two or four year college/university or trade school.
6. Candidate(s) must have a dedication to their faith, community and in helping others.
7. All information provided must be verifiable.

Selection Criteria

Scholarships will be awarded to all applicants who meet the prerequisites as stated in the eligibility requirements as determined by the Officers' of Council 6100.

All applicants will fill out and submit an official application as provided by Council 6100. The application is available on the Council website www.kofc6100.org.

Process

Application and other scholarship information is available online at the council 6100 website. The application submission deadline is April 21st.

Funding

Funding for this scholarship will be provided by donations.
